

## Drilling To Commence End June 2021

Polymetals Resources Ltd (“Polymetals” or the “Company”) is pleased to report that its planned 5,120 metre Alahiné drilling programme remains on schedule to commence end June 2021.

Site roadworks and drill pads are under construction and drilling contractor, Target Drilling, is preparing equipment for mobilisation.

The drill programme will consist of +50 holes using a combination of Air Core (**AC**) and Reverse Circulation (**RC**) drilling aimed at testing the shallow paleoplacer and underlying quartz hosted gold mineralisation identified via soil sampling and initial RC drilling.

Samples will be analysed by SGS Laboratories at its Bamako, Mali facility.
